

Tips for an Effective Legislator Meeting

Checklist: Before, During & After Meeting with Legislators

Be clear on your goal. You want legislators to know the purpose of the meeting and what, if any, actions you want them to take.
Stay on message and provide clear, concise points. Give your legislator a one-page handout outlining your issues and proposed solutions.
Know where your legislator stands on the issue. If you are unsure, ask!
Relay the impact of a specific program or bill to your legislator or candidate. Tell them how it affects their constituents.
Follow up the meeting with a personal thank you. If your legislator voted for legislation that helped your district, or they state they will support an issue, tell them thank you.
