



Bio: Frank Wood

Nominee for IASB President-Elect



Frank Wood represents Director District #6 in eastern Iowa on the IASB Board of Directors. He began his service on the IASB Board in 2023. He is currently in his third term on the North Scott Schools Board of Directors. During his tenure, Wood has served on the Bargaining, Superintendent Search, Facilities Planning, and Finance & Audit Committees, and the Curriculum Cabinet.

Wood earned his Master of Education Administration from Western Illinois University and worked in public education for 47 years. Wood has worked as a physical education & health teacher, athletic director, dean of students, assistant principal, and principal, working his final 21 years at North Scott Schools. In 1997, he was selected Administrator of the Year for the Blackhawk region in Illinois and received Assistant Principal of the Year for the southeast district in Iowa in 2020. Wood served as the president of the North Scott Kiwanis, the Mayor of Eldridge, and in the Iowa Senate from 2004–08 and the Iowa House of Representatives from 2012–14. For the past six years he has supervised student teachers through St. Ambrose University.

He sits on the IASB Governance and Bylaws Committee and has earned his first Annual Board Award this past year for his ongoing commitment to learning. This award is given annually to individual board members who participate in IASB learning opportunities, show a desire to take on leadership roles and engage in service and advocacy.

Wood has been married to his wife, Peggy, for 51 years. They have two grown children, six grandchildren and reside in Eldridge, Iowa.
