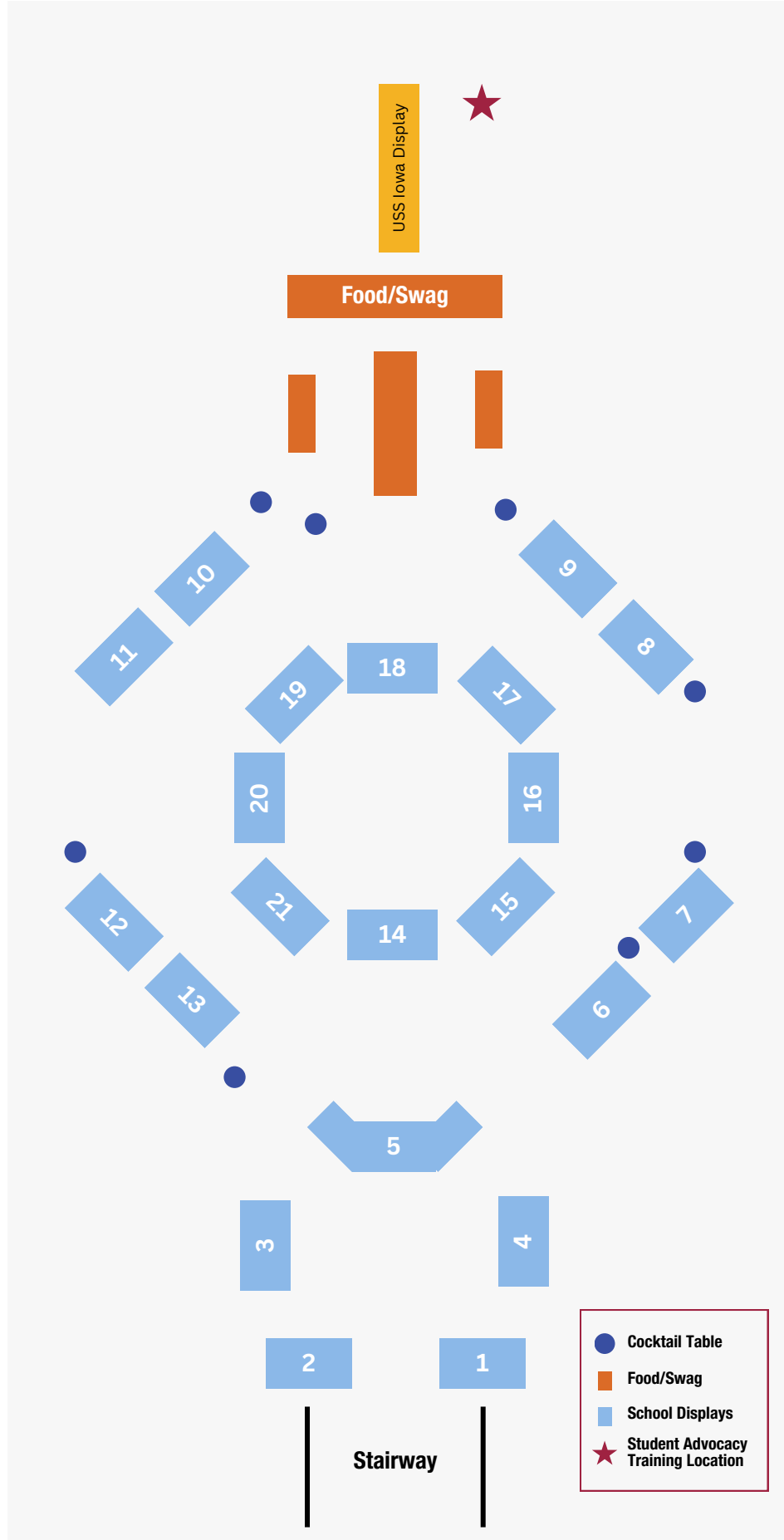

7. Woodbine—iJAG

Iowa Jobs for America's Graduates (iJAG) partners with Iowa schools to deliver career development programming.

8. Waterloo—IT Programming and Cybersecurity

The program covers Python programming, databases, web development, and cybersecurity.

9. Pleasantville—Pleasantville FFA

Offering hands-on experiences like a teaching farm, shop, land labs, and a greenhouse for all students.

10. Maquoketa/Storm Lake—Classroom Clinic

Classroom Clinic provides access to children's mental health services through telehealth and related technologies.

11. Davenport—LETRS Training and Amplify Curriculum

Showcasing how LETRS professional learning has enabled DCSD teachers to effectively implement the new Amplify curriculum.

12. Green Hills AEA—Rising Hope Academy

A therapeutic classroom environment for students with significant social emotional behavior health needs.

13. Linn-Mar—Venture Academics

Venture Academics is a project-based learning program where high school students apply coursework to real-world projects, develop 21st-century skills, and connect with local businesses and professionals for mentorship and career exposure.

14. Cedar Rapids—Early Literacy

Early literacy programs are crucial as they lay the foundation for future academic success and lifelong learning.

15. Alburnett—Alburnett 3DE

3DE is an experiential learning instructional model that embeds real world work into the curriculum in partnership with local businesses.

16. Winterset—WHS Cybersecurity Program

Paradigm, a cybersecurity course program, enables students to complete courses and earn Industry Recognized Credentials.

17. Oskaloosa—#ALLIN for All-Day Pre-K

Emphasizing the importance of funding all-day preschool for 4-year-olds, demonstrating its positive impact on early learning, school readiness, and community strength through stories and data.

18. Marshalltown—TPRA

The Para to Teacher Registered Apprenticeship program has enabled current classified employees at MCSD to transition into teaching roles!

19. Olin—Mini Farm / Farm-to-Table / Agricultural STEM Education

Focusing on the chicken husbandry project and related STEM education, while also highlighting future initiatives like prairie restoration and sustainable agriculture projects.

20. ADM—TechRise

The TechRise team from Iowa was selected among fifty nationwide in a FutureEngineers and NASA-supported challenge. They designed, built, and tested an experimental payload, which was launched on a high-altitude balloon to collect data.

21. Cardinal—4-Day School Week

Students will present the benefits that Cardinal has experienced since implementing the four-day school week calendar.
