Board Books: IASB updates the School Board Member Handbook each election year.

<u>New Board Member Portal</u>: Whether you've got a newly appointed or newly elected board member, check out the New Board Member Portal. *Pro tip:* Share the Glossary of Education Terms with your newbies.

<u>Open Meetings & Public Records</u>: All boards must adhere to lowa's Open Meetings Law. *Pro tip:* Check out this document with information explaining the motions to enter into a closed session.

<u>Board Presidents' Corner</u>: This section has many helpful resources for board presidents and superintendents. *Pro tip:* Review the <u>Board Presidents' Budget Calendar</u> to help your board stay up-to-date with oversight and monitoring.

<u>Tentative Agreement Data</u>: IASB collects tentative agreements from districts during the negotiation season. *Pro tip:* This data is compiled into a district-by-district summary report.

<u>Salary and Benefits Data</u>: IASB offers downloadable spreadsheets to help you compare salary and benefits data for staff positions. These are based on the BEDS data reports. Review FY 2023 data.

<u>Superintendent Updates</u>: IASB tracks superintendent transitions each year. Check out where they've been, where they're going, and who's new.

Online Policy Subscription Service: The Policy Reference Manual is one of IASB's most popular services. The subscription-based service provides districts with online access to more than 430 sample policies. Additional resources included with the subscription include the Policy Primer Newsletter; a list of mandatory policies, and Title IX resources.
