IOWA CODE 80.45A—IOWA'S NEW TRAINING LAW FOR LODGING PROVIDERS

<u>lowa Code 80.45A</u> creates a new training requirement for lowa lodging providers who host public employees or publicly funded events and conferences. Beginning January 1, 2022, affected lodging providers must have all employees successfully complete certified human trafficking prevention training in order to receive public funds as payment for services. IASB recommends members confirm lodging providers have met this requirement before booking accommodations. For more information, visit the <u>lowa Office to Combat Human Trafficking website</u>.
