#### ADVOCACY IN ACTION

The first funnel deadline is just around the corner on **March 7**. As a reminder, to survive the funnel deadline, a bill must pass through a committee in either chamber. However, the deadline will not impact Appropriations or Ways & Means bills. Make sure you're in-the-know on all Capitol happenings
