IASB offers various data tools that provide you, your board, and your district with specific data and the ability to compare your district's data with that of other districts.

The Department of Management recently released its FY 2027 Aid and Levy Budget file. Using this information, IASB has updated tools that allow comparisons of budget data, including property tax rates, income surtax rates, and other funding amounts for each school district.
