Adel-De Soto-Minburn Senior Awarded \$2,000 Special Education Teacher Scholarship

After earning her degree from Northwestern College, Manning hopes to teach at an elementary school here in lowa where she'll have the opportunity to work with students who have special needs of differing severities. "I plan on teaching for as long as I am able to and I want to reach as many students as I possibly can," Manning said.
